Ms. Whetzel noted that the VATI 2020 grant application for the Middlebrook project was challenged by a local provider (HSL). The provider noted addresses in the area that utilize their service. The County is drafting a response, noting that the application is for fiber-to-the-home, so some of the addresses are outside the project area. A response is due in early November.

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Old Business

The Committee reviewed a draft form that attempts to simplify the draft Request for Proposal related to the Design and Construction of Broadband Infrastructure in Augusta County. The procurement process will follow the Virginia Public Private Educational Facilities and Infrastructure Act (PPEA). The form follows the requirements set forth in the PPEA. The Committee noted to further clarify or include: notation that lead time should be included in schedule, need for liquidated damages/bonding/risk assurance, need for resumes, add a checklist, add a flow chart, and add directions for line items within the form/questions.

New Business

Mr. Powell updated the Committee on New Hope Telephone's fiber project.

It was noted that Rural Utilities Service (RUS) USDA was financing 253 million feet of fiber in Virginia in the next few months.
