Matters to be Presented by Staff

Ms. Whetzel reviewed the Request for Information for the VATI 2020 grant with the Committee. The RFI included the project areas identified by the Sub-Committees. The RFI allowed the providers to focus on the project specific requirements, and the County would assist with vetting other provider criteria and mapping required by the grant. The RFI is due August 5, 2019 and the grant is due September 3, 2019.

Ms. Whetzel reviewed the surveys completed to date (1,142).



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Old Business

The Committee continued discussions about the possibility of putting out an RFI that would remain active for a longer period of time, allowing area providers to submit a proposal for a project that may not suit a grant application. The County has small areas where service is needed that may be better suited for a local project. Providers would note what project they would like to do, the financial margin needed and market the project to the County. Local homeowner's associations could see if this would be an option to them also, if they can partner with a provider and fund a portion of the project. Consideration of speed provided, project readiness and citizen input would be reviewed. Ms. Whetzel will check on the formalities of procurement for this type of solicitation. The Committee can broach this idea with the Board of Supervisors and request a budget be funded for the local match.
