

Augusta County Electoral Board Meeting Minutes January 6, 2023 10:00 am.

I. Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 am. Dave Leatherwood, Vic Ludlum and Brenda vonSeldeneck were in attendance. Georgia Alvis-Long, a current member of the State Board and former Secretary of the Augusta County Electoral Board, was an invited guest.

VII. New Business:
