Ms. Whetzel provided an update on the VATI 2021 grant that is under construction by MGW/Lingo Networks. Permitting and construction work continued in project areas. Three permits were received from Dominion Energy and the areas were to construction. MGW is waiting on one SVEC permit and is going to submit three more permit requests. An extension is considered due to weather delays, staff out with COVID and now supply chain issues. For example, a small grummet piece on backorder will cause a delay. DHCD considers extensions in 6 month blocks. Below is a summary of work to date. Please note that milestones are set on two month increments, so therefore the passings will be updated every other month.

Ms. Whetzel updated the Committee on the status of the contract with DHCD. The Board of Supervisors approved the Fiscal Agent Agreement on April 27, 2022. Concerns were raised regarding the accountability of the project as the oversight is under the Northern Shenandoah Valley Regional Commission and DHCD. Mr. Slaven summarized the actions of the Board related to the project. Citizens have been requesting service and the regional project is a way to expand the service coverage in the County. Universal coverage is defined as 97% of homes with access to 25/3 mbps. The project will make significant gains in coverage.

Economic Development will have an intern that can work on the mapping project.

Ms. Whetzel distributed a draft press release for the VATI2021 project. MGW will review.

The federal Communications Commission is seeking comment on preventing digital discrimination. Comments are due by May 16, 2022.

Ms. Whetzel attended a marketing research group meeting for BARC on March 25, 2022. Input surrounded how BARC can deliver services to the community as an internet provider.

Ms. Whetzel and Mr. Henderson attended a roundtable discussion on April 12, 2022 at Augusta Health with Senator Warner. The focus was telehealth and broadband.

DHCD issued guidelines for the Line Extension Customer Assistance Program. The program will support the extension of existing broadband networks to low-to-moderate income residents.
