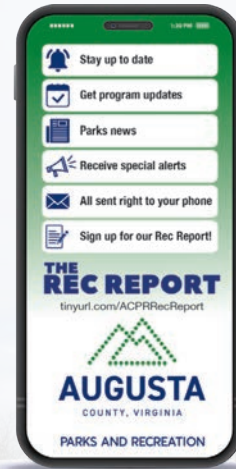

Weather can be unpredictable. Please check the forecast before coming to the pool as no refunds or rain checks will be issued. When there is lightening within ten miles of a pool we must evacuate for the safety of all. Cash and check are accepted at both Stuarts Draft and Natural Chimneys pools. Credit Cards are accepted only at Natural Chimneys pool. Regretfully we are not currently able to accept credit cards at Stuarts Draft pool.

**Open Daily** from Saturday, May 25 - Sunday, August 4 (weather permitting); **Open on Saturdays and Sundays only** from Saturday, August 10 - Sunday, August 25. **Labor Day Weekend** Open Saturday, August 31 - Monday, September 2.

# 2024 Swim Lessons

## AT STUARTS DRAFT POOL

Registration for summer 2024 swim lessons opens on April 20, 2024.

Swim lessons are offered based on the child's age as well as the following skill levels. If you are unsure which level of swim lesson to place your child in, please call our office for assistance.

- **Beginner:** For the child who has never had swimming lessons or the child who is apprehensive about submerging his/her/their face and head. For ages 3-5 or 6-12.
- **Intermediate:** For the child who has had previous lessons and is comfortable above and underwater. The child should be able to swim with a flutter kick & arm stroke, and float on their back and front with minimal assistance. This class takes place in deep end of pool, where max depth is 5'. For ages 6-12.

The swim lessons consist of 25 minutes of instruction followed by 5 minutes of play. Each session of swim lessons has a minimum number of participants required, but there is also a maximum number of participants allowed in each session to ensure a quality, individualized experience for all participants. Makeup dates for each session will be shared upon registration.

### NRA Home Firearm Safety/Double A Tactical Basic Firearms Course

**\*Ages 18+**

This is a five-hour course for safe gun handling that is conducted in the classroom only. Students are taught NRA's three rules for safe gun handling, primary causes of firearms accidents, firearm parts, how to load and unload certain action types, ammunition components, cleaning, care, safe storage of firearms and ammunition and the benefits of becoming an active participant in the shooting sports. Students will receive a course completion certificate. Safety comes before all else. This class will meet requirements for the Virginia Concealed Carry Permit. Any U.S. citizen may apply for a non-resident Utah CFP after taking this required course. Before applying for the Utah CFP, you must obtain a concealed carry permit from your home state. ## CAMPING FOR 2024

Our campground is designed and managed for 'family-style' camping and we encourage all campers to consider this when making reservations or plans to stay with us.

Site-load capacities are:

- 8 people per site/per night
- 1 RV, trailer, or pop up camper and one tent allowed per site
- 2 parked vehicles (in addition to the camping unit/rig) per site
- 2 tents allowed on sites with no RV, trailer, or pop-up

Please note: there is a two-week (14 night) time limit for all reservations, this includes the use of our camper storage program.

## MAKING RESERVATIONS FOR CAMPING SEASON 2024

- Great news! We have a new online reservation tool - an interactive map of campsites. Narrow down your campsite selection and choose a campsite with just a few clicks on our new Graphical Map search tool!
- Reservations are made by specific campsite.
- Payment of the full camping fee is required when making a reservation. We accept cash, check or credit card (Visa, Mastercard or Discover).
- Only campers who will be staying on a site may make reservations for that site, and only one site can be reserved per household per day.
- Check-in time is 2:00 pm and check-out time is 12:00 noon.

### Cancellation & Refund Policy:

Should a reservation be cancelled more than 48 hours prior to check-in, a \$5.00 per night cancellation fee will be deducted and the balance will be refunded to the camper (maximum fee of \$20.00). Refunds on payments originally made by credit card will be reapplied to that card. Refunds on payments originally made by cash or check will be refunded by check. Any reservations cancelled less than 48 hours prior to check-in will not receive a refund.

### Transfer Policy:

- Existing reservations cannot be transferred to another date without incurring additional fees. This would constitute a cancellation and re-booking, and established change fees would apply.
- Standing reservations may be transferred to another available camp site for the same date(s). In such cases no refunds are provided if the new site is a lesser cost.

### Cancellation & Refund Policy:

- Should a reservation be cancelled more than 48 hours prior to check-in, a \$5.00 per night administrative fee will be deducted and the balance will be refunded. Refunds on payments originally made by cash and check will be refunded by check. Any reservations cancelled less than 48 hours prior to check-in will not receive a refund.

### REGISTRATION

Participants must register before the start of all programs; you are not considered registered for a program unless payment is made in full. Augusta County Parks and Recreation’s programs have a minimum and maximum number of participants. Registration is accepted on a first-come, first paid basis until a program is full. Once a program is full, ACPR may take names for a waiting list but does not guarantee anyone on a waiting list acceptance into a program. ACPR reserves the right to cancel a program due to lack of enrollment. In such a case, enrollees will be promptly notified of the cancellation. You may register online, by mail, by phone, or in person at our office.

### PAYMENT

Payment in full is due at the time of registration, unless the specific activity/trip/program description outlines an otherwise approved payment schedule that includes an initial deposit. You may pay by check, cash, Visa, MasterCard, or Discover. Please do not send cash with mail in registrations. All checks and money orders are payable to Augusta County Parks and Recreation or ACPR. A \$30 return check fee is charged for all returned checks.

### ONLINE REGISTRATION TIPS

You may register for our programs online using WebTrac. Go to [www.augustarec.com](http://www.augustarec.com) and click on “Online Registration”. This will take you to our online registration system.

Once you get to WebTrac follow these steps:

Step 1: Sign in with your username and password or create a new account. If you can’t remember your username or password, just click “Need your username/password?” and your information will be sent to the email address associated with your account.

Step 2: Find the activity you desire, check for additional information and availability, then register!

**Note:** after clicking the shopping cart icon to register for an activity, a window will appear at the bottom of your screen. Click on “Enroll Now” and you will be taken through the payment process.



## REFUNDS & CANCELLATIONS

Full refunds will be given if Augusta County Parks and Recreation cancels a class, program, trip, etc. With any registration cancellation, a \$10 cancellation fee will be retained (or the full fee if less than \$10).

For activity and class programs (non-trips), refunds will be given up until 5 business days prior to when a program begins, minus the \$10 cancellation fee. If pre-purchases have been made, these costs will also be deducted from the refund. No refunds will be approved after this date unless special circumstances warrant.

For all trip programs, no refunds will be given, unless your space on the trip can be filled. If a waiting list exists, ACPR will contact those on the waiting list to try to fill the space(s). If no waiting list exists OR those on the waiting list no longer want to participate in the trip, it will be the responsibility of the participant to resell their space(s) on the trip. In many cases, the department must make pre-purchases; therefore, this refund policy is not flexible. Note that the \$10 cancellation fee will apply, even if the space is filled.

## OVERNIGHT TRIP POLICY

For all overnight trips a minimum of \$75 deposit per person is required to reserve your space. Deposits are non-refundable unless the trip is cancelled by ACPR. If a person from a double/triple room withdraws from the trip or fails to pay the balance, it will be the responsibility of the remaining roommate(s) to pay the difference on the new room rate.

Accident insurance is not provided by Augusta County Parks and Recreation for any program participant.

## Reassessment Appeals to Board of Equalization

Augusta County property owners who would like to formally appeal the reassessed value of real property may do so to the Board of Equalization (BOE) starting in June 2024. Once set, hearing dates will be advertised in the paper and on [www.AugustaCountyVA.gov](http://www.AugustaCountyVA.gov).

After reviewing the in-person or written appeal, the BOE will determine whether to increase, decrease, or affirm the assessment. The BOE is a formal proceeding and the board presumes that the reassessed value is correct.

The taxpayer or agent must present clear evidence that the assessment of the property is not uniform with the assessments of other similar properties or that the property is assessed in excess of its fair market value. Comparable sales data, property information, and details on incorrect property statistics should be presented for an appeal to the BOE.

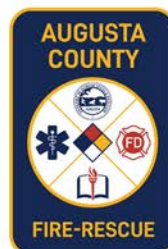

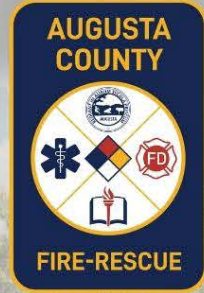

## SWIMMING SAFETY

NEVER leave a child alone in a pool, even for a moment to “catch the phone”, get a drink or any other reason. The majority of accidents happen when you “turn your back”. You should never swim alone at any age and always have some type of life saving equipment handy. (Life jackets, rings, etc.) Consider taking a Water Safety Class, CPR and First Aid, let’s hope you never have to use any training, but, if you need it, wouldn’t it be good to have. Use caution and sense when working with pool chemicals.



## STAY COOL!

Cooling Applications will be accepted from June 15th-August 15th. Assistance is for low-income households. Please remember Cooling Assistance requires a vulnerable person in the home. This means there must be a child 5 or under, an adult 60 or older or someone 100% disabled by the state or veterans in the home. This program also helps with repairs to cooling systems, purchase of an air conditioner for households without any air conditioning, and Security Deposits.

How can Headwaters Soil & Water Conservation District assist farmers in conserving our natural resources, while remaining profitable? The answer may be the **Virginia Agricultural Cost Share (VACS)** program! The program is administered by the Virginia Department of Conservation & Recreation through local soil and water conservation

districts (SWCDs) to improve or maintain water quality in the state's streams, lakes and bays.

Through these financial programs, technical assistance, and the tax credit program, incentives are offered to carry out the construction or implementation of selected Best Management Practices (BMPs) to reduce activities that may result in nonpoint source pollution. The program offers more than 50 conservation practices that cover the full spectrum of agricultural operations.

Popular project types include:

- Stream Fencing and Alternative Watering Systems
- Riparian Buffer Tree Planting on Crop/Pastureland
- Animal Waste Storage Facilities
- Winter Cover Crops
- Cropland Conversion to Hay or Pasture
- Runoff Management
- Extension of Watering System with Rotational Grazing Management Plans

The Headwaters Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) is one of 47 Soil and Water Conservation Districts in the Commonwealth of Virginia. Formed in 1975, the Headwaters SWCD is a part of the state government which provides citizens the structure and the capability to solve conservation problems at a local grassroots level. Headwaters SWCD serves Augusta County and the Cities of Staunton and Waynesboro.
