### Augusta County Fire-Rescue Duty Officer Notification

Upon receipt of an incident that meets the below event type criteria, the Augusta County Emergency Communications Center will dispatch and alpha page the Augusta County Fire-Rescue Duty Officer.

<i>Event Type / Description</i>
Traffic / Motor Vehicle Crashes: Bus Aircraft Train Multiple vehicles Involving County apparatus with or w/o injuries Requiring three (3) or more transport units
Special Rescue Operations (Trench, Confined Space, Heavy Rescue)
Airport alerts
Aircraft, bus and train emergencies
Structure fires with smoke and fire visible, working incidents, special request (s) equivalent to a second alarm assignment or greater, multi alarm assignments
Extended Police Operations (TAC, SWAT, bomb threats)
Hazardous Material Incidents to include but not limited to confirmed release or spills greater than 25 gallons
Fire emergencies involving County owned Property

Fire incidents resulting in an injury or death of an emergency service provider
Civilians - Fire injury / fatalities
Explosions or incidents involving explosives and magazines
MCI
Incidents involving County or State Elected Officials
Suspicious fire events / Suspected arson
Natural Disasters to include weather events / alerts
Large scale evacuation requiring the opening of shelters
Upon request
ECC implementation of the priority dispatch system
NCIC/VCIN Hazard alerts / updates / notifications
County Offices closings
Fire emergencies involving or at a church
Vehicle into a structure
Confined Space – Entry (ACSA)
Working incidents or multi alarm response assignments outside Augusta County involving Fire-Rescue agencies dispatched by Augusta ECC. Listed are some, but not limited to the geographical areas affected: Cities: Staunton, Waynesboro, Harrisonburg, Lexington Counties: Rockingham, Rockbridge, Nelson, Highland, Bath
