### **Working Incident**

The universal term to obtain additional manpower but not an additional alarm level to a dispatched Fire-EMS event is known as a "working incident"

When deemed necessary to upgrade a dispatched Fire-EMS event to a working incident, Emergency Service Personnel will contact the Augusta County Emergency Communications Center on the assigned operational frequency and request a "working incident".

Upon receipt to upgrade a dispatched Fire-EMS event to a working incident, Augusta ECC will:

#### **Fire Events**

- > Retone **ALL** Fire-Rescue agencies currently working the incident
- Dispatch the Augusta County Fire-Rescue Duty Officer.
- > Dispatch an additional fire agency on the response assignment.
- Dispatch a rescue agency on the response assignment. (If a rescue unit/agency is not currently on the response assignment)
- > Inquire if Rehab 1 is needed

#### **EMS Events**

- > Retone **ALL** Fire-Rescue agencies currently working the incident.
- Dispatch the Augusta County Fire-Rescue Duty Officer.
- > Dispatch additional resources upon request.

#### **MVC - Traffic Crashes**

- > Retone **ALL** Fire-Rescue agencies working the incident.
- > Dispatch the Augusta County Fire-Rescue Duty Officer.

Upon receipt to activate a working incident or increase the alarm level for a dispatched event in Augusta County, Augusta ECC will automatically <**Add**> the next

due fire agency (s) on all additional (emergency) calls originating to fire agencies dispatched to the working incident.
